

POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP IN NEUROIMAGING FOR MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS

The Neuroimmunology Group offers a postdoctoral position to work in the field of imaging, studying the human retina to improve our knowledge on brain diseases. The selected candidate will be trained in the new field of imaging the human retina through the use of high resolution optic coherence tomography (OCT), multifocal evoked potentials, and spectroscopy combined with brain MRI studies and computational analysis and modeling. In addition, the candidate will be trained in Neuroimmunology and Multiple Sclerosis as well as in Neuro-Ophthalmology and Systems Neurosciences.

We are seeking a highly motivated neurologist (other backgrounds could be considered) interested in carrying a research in this new and promising field. The only language requirement is English. We offer a 2 year fellowship with a competitive salary and opportunities of exchange with our collaborating groups at UCSF (Prof. A. Green) and ICFO (Prof. D. Petrov). The fellowship is funded by Roche, giving to the applicant the opportunity to be exposed to the industrial sector of biomedical research. The applicant will be joining our team by the end of 2009 or the beginning of 2010.
